Impact100 Hunterdon Announces “Big Reveal”

Impact100 Hunterdon will announce the total membership for 2024 at event on July 24th

The Hunterdon Chapter of Impact100 will announce its total membership for 2024 at an event on Wednesday, July 24th, 2024 from 6:00pm – 8:00pm. The event will take place at the Stangl Factory at 12 Mine Street in Flemington, NJ and light fare will be served. There is no charge for the event, thanks to the generous sponsorship of Shoprite of Hunterdon County. Impact 100 Hunterdon welcomes those interested in joining or learning more to join fellow members, sponsors and local nonprofits to toast the first year of giving and the impact that will be made together in our Hunterdon County community.

The Impact100 model is simple: at least 100 women come together to donate at least \$1,000 each so that a \$100,000 transformational grant can be made to a local charity. Grants are available to eligible nonprofits across five broad focus areas: Arts & Culture; Family; Education; Health & Wellness; and Environment, Preservation, and Recreation. Impact100 is dedicated to offering women a framework to help take their philanthropic work to the next level, making a transformational difference in their communities. Impact100 is a place for women who care deeply, who dream wildly, and who believe that, together, they are an unstoppable force for good.

Founded in 2023 in partnership with Binnacle House Community Foundation, Impact100 Hunterdon believes that women have the power to transform the Hunterdon community through collective giving. The new chapter has been driving towards a goal of 100 women in

membership for the 2024 grant cycle. They announced the grant process in June and opened grant applications on July 1, 2024. The chapter will award a \$100,000 transformational grant to a Hunterdon County nonprofit in November. More than just a fundraising effort, Impact100 Hunterdon provides events, networking, and educational opportunities to gather women together and become a collective force for good. The group aims to spread awareness about the needs in Hunterdon County, the work that Hunterdon nonprofits are doing, and how everyone can make a difference.
